Normeca AS

History

Normeca AS (www.normeca.no) has since its start in 1983 and until 1993 primarily been engaged in selling to the domestic health care market in Norway. The main areas have been anaesthesia, ICU, CCU and emergency care. Products have been imported primarily from Denmark, Sweden, Germany, England and USA.

Normeca AS has been the leading Norwegian supplier of anaesthesia machines and ventilators since 1983 and until around 2000. During most of these years our market share was approx. 90-97 %. Normeca AS was in many years the only company in Norway that was able to offer a complete range of gas-related medical equipment, from centralised gas supply systems to the tube in the patients' mouth.

For many years, Normeca AS had agreements with 65-70 % of the Norwegian hospitals for preventive maintenance on anaesthesia machines and ventilators. This is carried out once or twice per year depending on the specific requirements.

Normeca AS has had an extensive program of courses relating to anaesthesia and to a lesser extent heart monitoring. A total of approx. 2.300 doctors, nurses and medical-technical personnel have attended these courses. Our course "Safety during anaesthesia" was a part of a curriculum for anaesthesiologists in Norway. The course is today being arranged by the Norwegian Government.

In addition Normeca AS has arranged a number of seminars on field hospitals both in Norway and abroad. These have been attended by approx. 1.500 people. Local seminars have been held in countries like amongst others Japan, South Korea, China, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand, Indonesia, Taiwan, India, United Arab Emirates, Hungary, Czech Republic, Poland, Great Britain, Portugal, U.S.A., Venezuela, Romania, Slovakia and Norway.

Today Normeca has become a disaster expert. Partly in cooperation with different NGOs and Governments around the world, amongst them the Japanese Red Cross, the Ministry of Health in Cuba, MSF, with more Normeca has delivered mobile and/or semi permanent hospitals to disaster and/or war areas in countries like Afghanistan, Albania, Kosovo, Pakistan, India, Thailand, Japan, Haiti, Iran, Indonesia and many more countries. The summer of 2010 Normeca AS built a semi-permanent (container based) Mother & Child Hospital for the Medicines Sans Frontiers (MSF) from Holland in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. In 2009 it delivered the two most sophisticated mobile hospitals in the world, to Saudi-Arabia's Ministry of Finance, for use at the annual Hajj in Mecca. The MultiSpace solution is our own design, based on expandable semitrailers.



The company's aim

The company's aim has changed substantially during the last years. Today its aim can be divided into categories as follows:

- To export mobile- and semi permanent hospitals, primarily to the world-wide "defence & emergency relief" markets.
- The company's aim is to be a leader in the world within storing mobile hospital and mobile clinics on behalf of GO and NGO.
- To export ambulances, ambulance boats and floating hospitals and clinics.
- To provide complete management and administration program related to ambulance, hospital and clinic deliveries.
- To sell medical equipment and disposables to the health care sector in Norway. Primary areas are anaesthesia, ICU, CCU, emergency areas and the operating theatre.
- To develop www.medclub.no as the leader of web shop in the field of medical equipment and disposables to doctor's office, nursing home, private health centres, etc. in Norway and later on in Sweden and Denmark.



Organisation

Normeca AS has approximately 20 employees working at the HQ in Norway and around 60 employees in total around the world. Additional manpower is continuously recruited during the periods of construction of our projects around the world. During the Sudan project Normeca had more than 400 manpower assigned for this activity only. Normeca AS also holds a recruitment base of 8000 applications searching for project assignment. This data base contains records for a wide range of different professions; doctors, dentists, nurses, engineers, architects, plumbers, electricians, mechanics, carpenters etc.

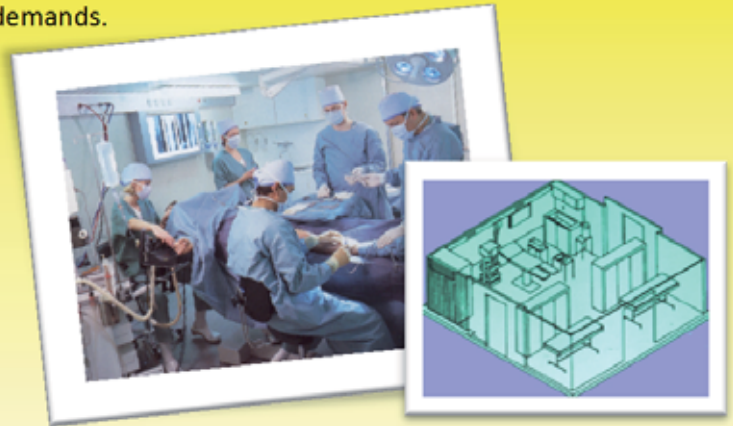

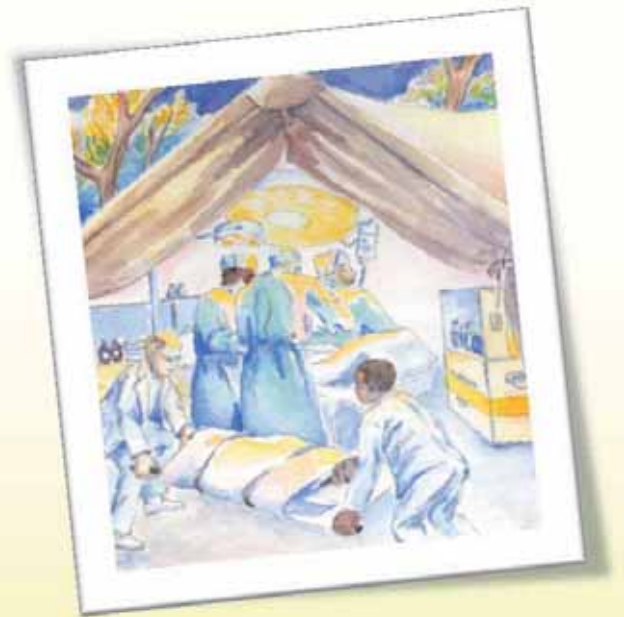

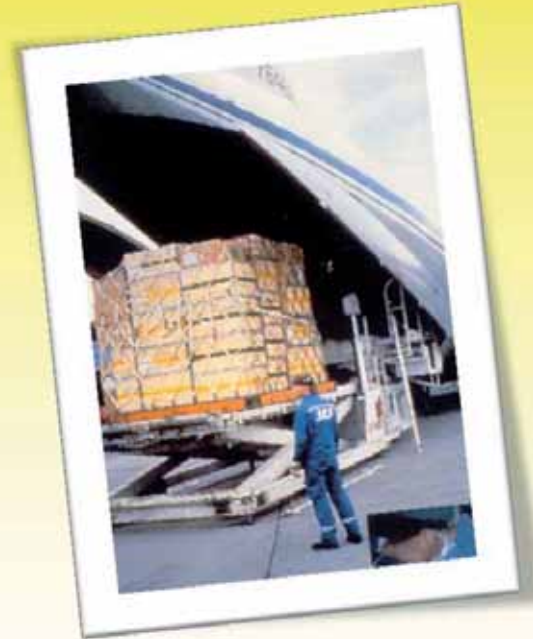

The following part of this document presents our previous projects and engagements. It shows the complexity and quantity of challenging international projects NORMECA group has delivered turnkey.

Sudan

In September 2006, Normeca AS signed its largest contract ever with the Government of Southern Sudan (GOSS), Ministry of Health, to dramatically improve the health care situation for the people of Southern Sudan. The contracts were signed by the Minister of Health in the presence of the President's Advisor, State Secretaries from the Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning and Ministry of Legal Affairs and Constitutional Development.

Under the contracts, Normeca AS should build 10 semi-permanent state hospitals in Southern Sudan each with 80 to 150 beds and accommodation for approximately 150 people for each hospital. Each hospital should have 5 mobile clinics, a total of 50. In addition, Normeca AS should provide 2 floating hospitals for the river Nile.

In addition, Normeca AS signed a 5 year management and operations agreement covering all hospitals and clinics. Unfortunately the project has stopped because of lack of funds.

Cuba

In October 2005 a heavy earth quake hit several areas in Pakistan. Rapid response is crucial, Normeca AS got an inquiry from Cuba's authorities for supplying of a field hospital based on tents that should be run by a Cuban medical team. The hospital was delivered in Muzaffarabad.



In December 2005 Normeca AS delivered a mobile hospital to Cuba for preparedness in Latin America. This hospital, based on tents, was moved to Indonesia after the earth quake in May 2006 and established there on behalf of the Government of Cuba by staff from Normeca AS.

Pakistan

During the first months of 2006 Normeca AS delivered a field hospital in Hattian Bala, Pakistan, for Medecins Sans Frontieres based on flat pack containers. This hospital included operating theatre, ICU, doctors' office, pharmacy, laboratory, blood bank, shower and toilets. The delivery was complete with generator, heating and cooling plants, water purifying system, etc.



Thailand and Indonesia

After the tsunami 26.12.2004 Normeca AS delivered a complete field hospital to Sumatra by the Japanese Red Cross. The company also build up the Site 2 in Mai Kao, Phuket, Thailand for identification of dead bodies. Normeca AS delivered this forensic medicine centre as a turnkey, and the company had the total responsibility for running the site, including, among others, logistic, catering, security and maintenance for 13 months.

After the tsunami the Thai Government reported 5 395 confirmed deaths, 8 457 injuries and 3 120 missing in Thailand from 44 countries. The Thai authorities estimated that 8 000 are likely to have died. A fantastic job was done by the local rescue workers and police with rescuing as many as possible, and also to get all the dead transported to the different temple areas. It was established DVI (Disaster Victims Identification) centres in Khao Lak, outside Phuket Town and in Krabi. The first couple of weeks the DVI personnel were forced to work outside under the open sky in extremely trying conditions.

It soon became evident that if the Government should be able to identify as many victims as possible, the working conditions had to change dramatically. Normeca AS suggested at an early stage to build up an Identification Centre based on flat packed containers with air conditioning, water supply and other necessary equipment.

India

GUJARAT– right after the earth quake in January, 2001
About 13.00 o'clock a.m. on the same day as the earth quake occurred, NORMECA A/S received the order from the Japanese Red Cross Society (JRCS).

The day after, at 06.00 o'clock in the morning all the equipment was made ready for transportation by air from Oslo Airport, Gardermoen.

In the afternoon of the same day two representatives from NORMECA A/S left for New Delhi together with the equipment.

In New Delhi the two persons` team from NORMECA organized customs clearance and further transporting by air to Buhj in the catastrophe area and also arranged arrival for the team from JRCS.

In the Buhj-area our team arranged certain number of working hands and reconnoitring together with organizing of reloading of the equipment, transportation, temporary billeting, etc.



Few hours after the establishing place had been decided, our hospital started to work.

The days to follow were used to some improvements, training of the JRCs team and local employers, and also to organizing of the supply of water, food and fuel. As far as we know, NORMECA A/S was the first external running hospital in the catastrophe area.

From the first day the hospital treated approx. 100 – 130 patients per day, most of these as out-patients.

Severely injured and sick persons were evacuated to the hospitals run by the Finnish / Norwegian Red Cross in Buhj.

During our staying in India we also received orders regarding further delivery of one more hospital – to the Medical Relief Unit (MeRU). This hospital was established in the town Rapar, about 180 km north-east for Buhj.

After this operation in India JRCs decided to purchase one hospital for preparedness storage at NORMECA A/S.

According to the contract between NORMECA A/S and JRCs, NORMECA A/S should arrange for the hospital to be transported to and started running at the actual effort site.

The hospital was ready for setting in the service from the summer 2001.

Afghanistan

BAGLAN-province after the earth quake in Mars 2002.

Also this delivery was executed for The Japanese Red Cross Society.

The assumptions for this delivery were somewhat different, since we had about two weeks at our disposal for making all necessary preparations.

It was just the case when the hospital stored for preparedness should be used, but we required some additional equipment - both medical and supporting material.



The transportation was carried out by trailer transport from NORMECA's warehouse to Billund in Denmark and further by charter flight Iljushin 76 directly to Mazar-i-Sharif in Afghanistan.

All reloading, arrival of the JRCs team and transportation to the earth quake area was arranged in collaboration with the International Red Cross Federation's sub office in Mazar-i-Sharif. The hospital was set up in Nharin area in Baghlan-province, approx. 260 km. from Mazar-i-Sharif.



Both setting up and starting of the hospital was quite quick and problem-free. This was thanks to the planning- and preparation work done earlier in connection with preparedness storage.

From the first day the hospital treated about 80 – 90 patients of all categories. Both medical and technical running worked quite satisfactory and in accordance with the plans.



Saudi Arabia

In 2009 Normeca delivered the two most sophisticated mobile hospitals in the world, to Saudi-Arabia's Ministry of Finance, for use at the annual Hajj in Mecca. The MultiSpace solution is Normeca's own design, based on expandable semitrailers.



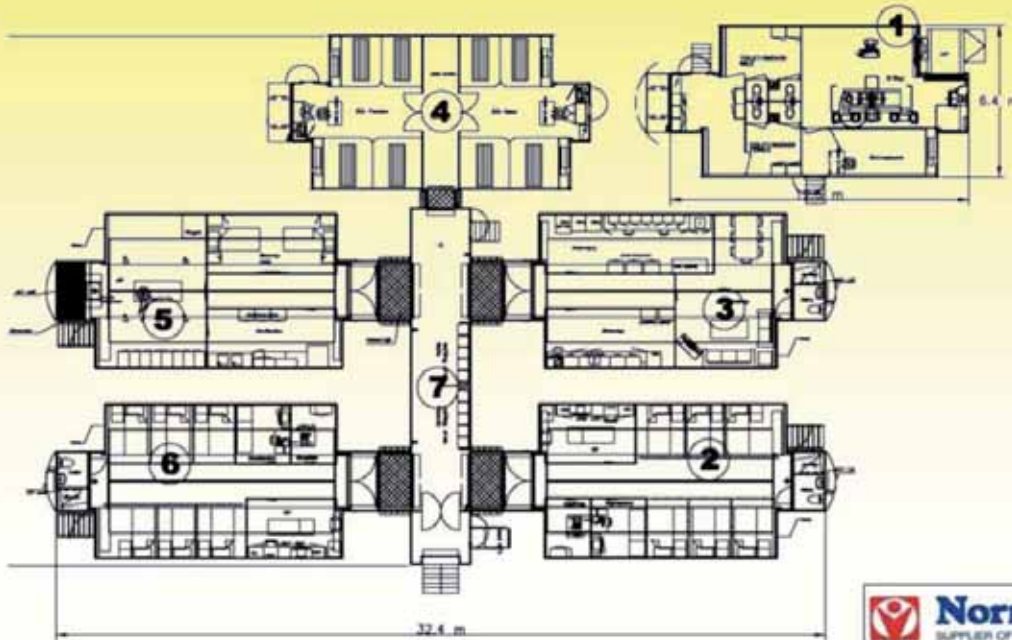
Normeca AS received an order from Ministry of Finance in Saudi-Arabia through our local agent for two complete mobile hospitals based in expandable MultiSpace semi-trailers. The contract also includes trailers and all medical equipment.

The hospital is built up from 7 trailers in total, one stand alone and six connected to each other

- One corridor single trailer with waiting area
- One female expandable trailer with reception, examination room, ER room and ward

- One male expandable trailer with reception, examination room, ER room and ward
- One lab/pharmacy expandable trailer with meeting- and relax room
- One OT expandable trailer with sterilization and recovery
- One ICU expandable trailer with 4 beds each female and male

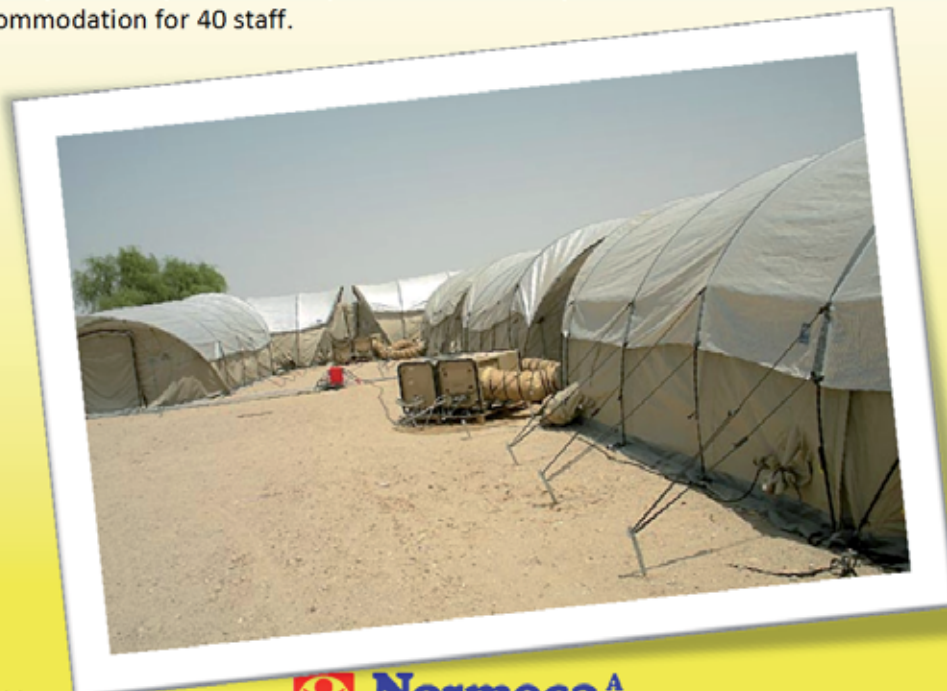

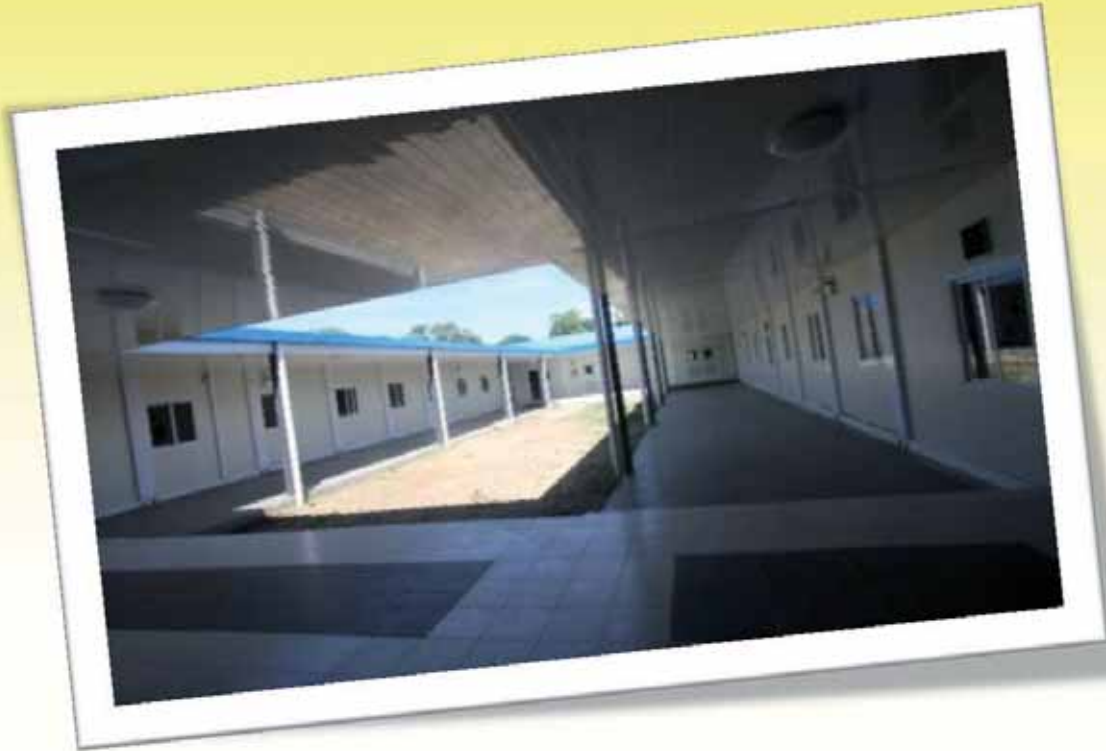
UAE

In 2009 Normeca AS delivered a complete 50 beds NBC protected hospital based in inflatable tents to UAE Army. The hospital was completed with NorHosp and NorAid modules incl. kitchen dining and accommodation for 40 staff.



Haiti

The summer 2010 Normeca built a semi-permanent (container based) 120 beds Mother & Child Hospital for the Medicines Sans Frontiers (MSF) from Holland in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.



Libya / Qatar

Mach 2011 Normeca AS delivered a complete 50 bed hospital with 40 bed accommodation based in inflatable tents to National Interim Transitional Council, Libya as a donation from Government of State of Qatar. The hospital was completed with NorHosp and NorAid modules incl. kitchen dining and accommodation for 40 staff.

Management

Normeca AS is standing by on call ready to go within a few hours all year. Our team can support in establishing the clinic and/or hospital and/or refugee camps, take care of the management and maintenance, after supply and support wherever it should be needed.

Furthermore, our management support team can also give support during dismantling and repacking of all equipment.

In Thailand after the Tsunami in 2004 Normeca AS had the total responsibility for running the site, including, logistic, catering, security and maintenance for 13 months.

In Southern Sudan Normeca AS had the total responsibility of running a 180 beds hospital and a 160 beds accommodation including hiring all staff, logistic, catering, security and maintenance for 15 months.

Training

Normeca works out a complete education and training program for all staff involved in any project. The focus is operating each module of equipment and infrastructure. We work out specific programs for each part of the education and training.

Normeca AS has trained around 1 500 anesthesiologists, anesthesia nurses and medical engineers in a period of 8 years and we trained around 1 200 people within 8 weeks all over Norway on decontamination.



New developing product

The containers are standard ISO 20" containers and they can be taken by air or road to site.

- All equipment for Accommodation, Kitchen and First Aid station can be packed inside the container during transport.
- All solutions have their own generator, compressor, water purifier and hot water system.







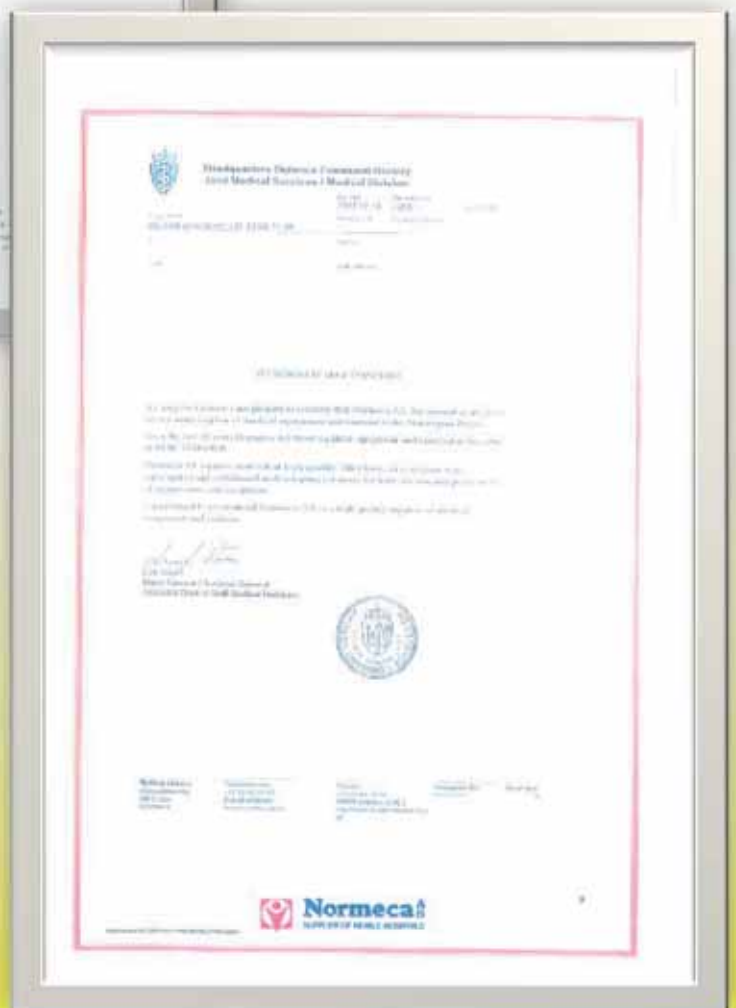

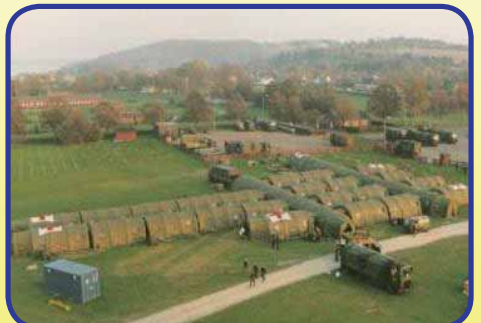
